The development of a fisheries plan for the Te Arawa River Iwi

This project involves the development of a fisheries plan for Te Arawa River Iwi – Tuhourangi-Ngati Wahiao; Ngati Tahu-Ngati Whaoa; Ngati Kea, Ngati Tuara. It will capture and record the matauranga or traditional fishing knowledge of each of the affiliate iwi.

It will use existing literature and through a series of Hui with TARIT advisory group and representatives from each of the iwi to develop targets and performance measures that will underpin the Te Arawa River Iwi fisheries plan.

The fisheries plan will enable TARIT to advise, consult and work with neighbouring iwi, community, agencies and fishers (customary, recreational and commercial) that share complementary freshwater fishing boundaries and interests.

An aim of the plan is to facilitate the most effective collective use of river iwi resources, skills and networks to ensure that both our fisheries and the habitat that supports them is preserved and enhanced for the benefit of current and future generations.
