1968

Our Crops

- We grow onions, potatoes, kiwifruit, pumpkin and squash for the local market, rotating with mustard and barley. We also include cattle rotations in our operation.
- **We produce over 10% of New Zealand's onion consumption per year (that currently equates to over 500,000 people we are feeding and the population in New Zealand is growing).**
- Providing home grown, high quality, nutritious produce for our people, while looking after the land and waterways, is our priority.
