We have 3-2km of creeks resulting in 6.4km of fencing consisting of posts/waratahas with 1-2 wires electrified. We have spent \$120,000 on a new effluent System VOLUNTARILY to Future proof the property from heavy rainfall and possible breakdowns. We apply effluent to the whole property apart from iolish ha of steeper land. Some riparian management plantings have been done but we are waiting for WRC to contact us RE: Variation 6 requirements as to what we require for it.
