I am writing on behalf of my husband and myself. We have been dairy berning in the Otorohanga region for 44 years. We run an average of 285 cows on 103h. We used to run a larger hard but reduced on stock numbers & now focus on more production per cow. Over the years use have ferred our drains and river banks (many years ago) and plated many thousands of rative trees. All ow native bush has been forced of and protected a we consider ourselves to be good custodiains of to land. Part of our farming operation includes a runoll half a kilometre up the road. We would wilk on this land but have no direct access therefore we run our young stock there instead Atthough we agree with Plan Change I in principle we disagree with some of the details. This Plan Charge will restrict on options severely with this land. It is extremely suitable for dairying, good well drawed soil, rolling contour a all waterways securely fenced. We are getting older a need to start looking at our options, one of which would be Selling this area to our dainy farming regulars. Plan Change I will reduce the value of this property makedly, possibly ruining ou retrement. We are deeply concerned that areas like this that are sinkle for dairying will never be able to be used a yet davy tuns that are existing in unsintable areas will, because they are already there, will be allowed to continue. Therefore I do not think that Plan Change I will acherise the desired effect and (beef-lamb) there fore oppose it.
