Plan Change 1 (PC1)

The Healthy Rivers Waiora Plan change is a great initiative to clean up our waterways. It is critical that we identify the main sources of the major contaminants are and fix those problems in the first instance.

It is preferable that a Catchment Management Approach is undertaken as opposed to a blanket set of rules, enforced by the Waikato Regional Council.

<u>Finding out the major sources of Nitrogen, Phosphorus, E.coli and Sediment and fixing those should be the first step in</u> <u>implement a plan change to clean up our waterways. This can be done, Catchment by Catchment allowing different</u> <u>solutions for different problems.</u>

The plan needs to be more targeted towards problem areas and fixing those first, based off actual test data as opposed to an estimation tool called Overseer.

In the instactice that a catchment management plan is unable to be implemented, then the following ammendments to the current plan are suggested:

Rule 2.1 – Nitrogen Reference Point (NRP)

For dairy farming, the 2014/15 or 2015/16 years can be choosen for the base years. It is requested this period is extended to a 5 year period to allow a degree of flexibily within the plan change. The 14/15 and 15/16 years were based of the two lowest payout periods in recent memory and as a result, inputs were reduced accordingly. There must be scope to have a wider spectrum of dairy seasons to choose from.

Rule 2.5 Stock Exclusion Rule

Supportive of excluding stock from waterways where is practically feasible. Providing a blanket rule for all waterways, despite the terrain will prove uneconomic for some.

Rule 7 – Land Use Change Rule

Request to have this land use change rule removed from PC1. Contaminant loading into the water ways must not exceed existing levels which will be governed by the Farm Environmental Plan and the Nitrogen Reference Point.

Additions to PC1

It is recommended that a provision for Nitrogen trading be added to PC1. If PC1 ends up in an Allocation Environment, the provision for trading must be allowed to allow a greater degree of flexibility for farmers. This will occur, without increasing the contaminant loading into the waterways.
